The club's fourth European trip takes us to Italy, where the best skiers in the world tackled the slopes of Cortina at the 1956 Winter Olympics. You too can ski those hallowed mountains in this picturesque Italian ski sanctuary. Guaranteed snow cover on 95% of the slopes combined with 8 hours of daily sunshine produce sublime skiing conditions at one of the world's premier ski resorts. Surrounded on all sides by the breathtaking Alps, ski resorts at Cortina encompass the very best that world-class skiing, entertainment, and shopping have to offer. Cortina is part of the Dolomiti Superski, which encompasses 12 resorts with 460 lifts and 475 trails. Cortina itself boasts a vertical drop of over 6,600 ft, and its 3 primary ski centers (Tofana, Cristallo and Faloria) are an intermediate skier's dream, with 50% cruising runs. On a break from skiing or simply done with the mountains for the day? The Corso Italia, a pedestrian paradise lined with quaint boutiques and exquisite restaurants, is the crown jewel of an environment swelling with allure and flavor that only Cortina can produce. Various day trips and non-skiing activities are available at an additional charge. We will be staying at the 4-star Hotel Concordia Parc. The trip will end with 2 days in Venice, where you can explore the city at your own pace. We will be staying at the Hotel Continental; on the Grand Canal and near the train station.

CORTINA POLICIES/TERMS/CONDITIONS

A. TRIP PAYMENT:

3. **Cancellation policy still applies.** Automatic cancellation if payments are not received on time and there is a waiting list.

B. GENERAL:

1. Prices are subject to change in transportation, lodging and lift ticket rates (and currency exchange -- where applicable).
2. Sign-up for all trips will start 28 Aug. 2010, and will require deposit in strict accordance with trip payment schedule.
3. All persons going on club sanctioned trips must be members of the BOEING EMPLOYEES' SKI CLUB – ST. LOUIS

C. CANCELLATION/TRANSFER FEES:

1. For each cancellation or transfer, minimum charge is \$20.00.
2. Transfer means to cancel from one Boeing Employees' Ski Club – St. Louis trip for the purpose of booking another Boeing Employees' Ski Club – St. Louis trip within the same season.
3. The trip captain will determine the charge for outright cancellations. Fees will be based on actual costs incurred, plus the \$20 service charge.

D. CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY:

1. To cancel a trip, the requester must make a **written request**. No refund will be made without a signed and dated written request.
2. Applicable cancellation fees listed in (C-3) will be levied if costs are incurred to execute the cancellation.
3. If no costs are incurred, the minimum charge (C-1) will be deducted from the refund.
4. If a suitable replacement is found, all money less minimum charge and actual cancellation costs specified in (C-3) will be refunded.
5. If a suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund will be made within four weeks after receipt of the replacement's appropriate payment(s).
6. If no suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund, if any, will be made within four weeks after the trip returns with a written request on file.
7. If the cancellation comes from a triple occupancy unit, and no suitable replacement is found, the person canceling will be responsible for the differential between the double & triple occupancy rate. This amount will be deducted from any refund.
8. The trip captain will provide a detailed explanation of costs incurred by cancellation to the requestor as part of the account settlement.
9. Any deviation from above will require action from the Club Refund Committee, consisting of the President, Executive Vice-President and Vice-President of Trips. Resolution of a deviation will be handled on a case-by-case basis. The \$20 minimum fee is irrevocable.
10. The Boeing Employees' Ski Club – St. Louis reserves the right to cancel the trip in its entirety if the number of attendees does not meet the minimum required to ensure financial viability. All attendee payments will be refunded if this action is taken.

E. OCCUPANCY: Trip is priced based on double occupancy.

F. SMOKING POLICY:

1. All unit assignments will be non-smoking regardless of lodging designation (ex. if the property manager lists the unit as "smoking").
2. The only exception to this policy will be if ALL roommates/condo mates agree to permit smoking in the unit.

THE BOEING EMPLOYEES' SKI CLUB - ST. LOUIS RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

I state that I wish to participate in activities offered by the Boeing Employees' Ski Club - St. Louis (hereinafter referred to as "the Club"), a Boeing Recreation Club. I **RECOGNIZE THAT ANY CLUB ACTIVITIES MAY INVOLVE CERTAIN RISKS AND DANGERS.** I certify that I am aware of all the obvious and inherent risks of the Club's activities, including but not limited to: inadequate safety equipment, miscalculations, inexperience, improper training, equipment malfunctions, human error, accidents or illness in areas without medical facilities, the forces of nature, and the actions of any other members, any participants or any other persons all of which may result in personal injury, death, property damage and other losses.

In consideration for the right to participate in the Club's activities, I **HEREBY RELEASE THE CLUB AND THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, INSTRUCTORS AND MEMBERS AND THE BOEING COMPANY, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, AND EMPLOYEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH MY PARTICIPATION IN ANY OF THE CLUB'S ACTIVITIES. I PERSONALLY ASSUME ALL RISKS IN CONNECTION WITH THESE ACTIVITIES, AND FURTHER AGREE TO INDEMNIFY THE CLUB AND ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, MEMBERS AND INSTRUCTORS, AND THE BOEING COMPANY, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, AND EMPLOYEES FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION WHICH I MAY HAVE ARISING FROM MY PARTICIPATION IN CLUB ACTIVITIES.** The terms of this agreement will serve as a release and indemnity agreement for my heirs, personal representative, and for all members of my family, including any minors.
