Devil's Head Mountain

Devil's Head is a full-service ski resort nestled in the heart of the glacier-formed, Baraboo Bluffs in South Central Wisconsin that has become a preferred ski area to Midwestern skiers and snowboarders. Various local and national ski magazines have chosen Devil's Head as one of the "Midwest's 10 Best Ski Resorts". Swimming, ice skating and other diversions are available when it's time to take a break from the slopes. Don't worry about keeping the kids happy – Devil's Head has endless entertaining activities available for the younger set. Après ski enjoy a variety of exquisite dining and live entertainment. And, at the end of a blissful day, it's only a short walk to the ultra-comfortable ski/in-ski/out accommodations that will bring a welcome respite from the excitement of the day.

Passionate skiers and snowboarders of all levels enjoy the Devil's Head diverse terrain. The ski slopes are pampered almost as much as the guests: they get groomed twice a day – the slopes that is – to make sure guests experience the best Wisconsin skiing possible.

Midwest skiers and boarders in-the-know go to Devil's Head ski resort for its new terrain parks with longer trails, more flow, and more rails in one run than any other ski area in Wisconsin. Devil's Head has been a longtime favorite of intermediate skiers because of its long, cruising slopes that create an exhilarating ride without the harshness of bumps and glades. Intermediate skiers aren't the only ones loving Devil's Head; beginner and advanced skiers have their fair share of exciting slopes, as well. And NIGHT Skiing 'til 10pm!

Cascade Mountain

Situated in the Baraboo Bluff region of south-central Wisconsin, Cascade's north-facing slopes offer real skiing variety. Some of the 34 trails, like the Mogul Monster, are steep and challenging to any skier, while trails like Adele's Alley are over a mile long and fun for beginners and cruisers. Getting to the top of the mountain is fast and easy with ten lifts, including the high-speed Mountain Top Express chairlift.

Cascade caters to the adventurous type with four terrain parks and a Super-pipe. Terrain parks are areas with manmade fun features like jumps and steel rails to slide on. Cascade has constructed over 30 acres of terrain parks, with over ten jumps and 20 rails.

Knowing that skiing or snowboarding isn't everyone's cup of tea, Cascade Mountain also has a snow tubing park with five tubing chutes, each about 800 feet long, and a surface lift to take you back up the hill for another ride. Tubing is fun and easy, and no experience is required. (Tubing is not included in the price of the trip.)

Skiing in Wisconsin just doesn't get any better than Devil's Head and Cascade Mountains. They have great snow, great accommodations, great amenities – and most important of all – great times just waiting to happen.

EACH PERSON MUST COMPLETE AN APPLICATION

A. TRIP PAYMENT:

1. Payment Schedule:

- \$160 Deposit (due with application)
- \$ TBD due 11/20/09 (total final price is expected between \$290 and \$320)

- 2. Automatic cancellation if payments are not received on time and there is a waiting list. Cancellation policy still applies.
- 3. **Make check payable to:** Boeing Employees' Ski Club - St. Louis.

B. GENERAL:

- 1. Prices are subject to change in transportation, lodging and lift ticket rates (and currency exchange -- where applicable).
- 2. Sign-up for all trips will start 22 Aug. 2009, and will require deposit in strict accordance with trip payment schedule.
All persons going on trips must be members of the BOEING EMPLOYEES' SKI CLUB
- 3. For membership information, contact Gary Robinson at (314) 780-1315.
- 4. Boeing Corporate Policy limits non-Boeing participation. Applicant acknowledges that they may be bumped from the trip if the required ratio of Boeing participants to non-Boeing participants is not met. Contact the Trip Captain for explanation of the BESC-STL bumping policy. See (C-4) for cancellation/refund information regarding the bumping policy.

C. CANCELLATION/TRANSFER FEES:

- 1. For each cancellation or transfer, minimum charge is \$20.00.
- 2. Transfer means to cancel from one Boeing Employees' Ski Club trip for the purpose of booking another Boeing Employees' Ski Club trip within the same season.
- 3. The trip captain will determine the charge for outright cancellations. Fees will be based on actual costs incurred, plus the \$20 service charge.
- 4. If the cancellation is caused by implementation of the BESC-STL bumping policy set forth in (B-4), all deposits will be refunded, and the \$20 cancellation fee will be waived.

D. CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY:

- 1. To cancel a trip, the requester must make a written request. No refund will be made without a signed and dated written request.
- 2. Applicable cancellation fees listed in (C-3) will be levied if costs are incurred to execute the cancellation.
- 3. If no costs are incurred, the minimum charge (C-1) will be deducted from the refund.
- 4. If a suitable replacement is found, all money less minimum charge and actual cancellation costs specified in (C-3) will be refunded.
- 5. If a suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund will be made within four weeks after receipt of the replacement's appropriate payment(s).
- 6. If no suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund, if any, will be made within four weeks after the trip returns and the written request is on file.
- 7. If the cancellation comes from a triple occupancy unit, and no suitable replacement is found, the person canceling will be responsible for the differential between the double & triple occupancy rate. This amount will be deducted from any refund.
- 8. The trip captain will provide a detailed explanation of costs incurred by cancellation to the requestor as part of the account settlement.
- 9. Any deviation from above will require action from the Club Refund Committee, consisting of the President, Executive Vice-President and Vice-President of Trips. Resolution of the deviation will be handled on a case-by-case basis. The \$20 minimum fee is irrevocable, except cancellations caused by conditions set forth in (B-4).
- 10. The Boeing Employees' Ski Club - St. Louis reserves the right to cancel the trip in its entirety if the number of attendees does not meet the minimum required to ensure financial viability. All attendee payments will be refunded if this action is taken.

E. OCCUPANCY:

Trip is priced based on double occupancy

F. SMOKING POLICY:

All unit assignments will be non-smoking regardless of lodging designation (ex. if the property manager lists the unit as "smoking"). The only exception to this policy will be if ALL roommates/condo mates agree to permit smoking in the unit.
