North Peak boasts steep mogul covered runs, and smooth cruisers that cater to the more advanced skier. The three mountains are easily accessible from the River Run Base area. The Outback features glade tree skiing to offer the adventurous intermediate and advanced skier's powder skiing long after the main runs turn to packed powder. Breckenridge Ski Resort boasts the largest ski resort in Summit County with 4 interconnected mountains and a total of 2,000 skiable acres. KEYSTONE MOUNTAIN TRIP POLICIES/TERMS/CONDITIONS

EACH PERSON MUST COMPLETE A SEPERATE APPLICATION AND RETURN TO TRIP CAPTAIN

A. TRIP PAYMENT:

1. **Make check payable to:** Boeing Employees' Ski Club - St. Louis
2. **Payment Schedule:** \$300 Deposit (due with application); \$295 due **10/8/10**; \$295 due **11/19/10**
3. **Cancellation policy still applies.** Automatic cancellation if payments are not received on time and there is a waiting list.

B. GENERAL:

1. Prices are subject to change in transportation, lodging and lift ticket rates (and currency exchange -- where applicable).
2. Sign-up for all trips will start 28 Aug. 2010, and will require deposit in strict accordance with trip payment schedule.
3. All persons going on club sanctioned trips must be members of the BOEING EMPLOYEES' SKI CLUB – ST. LOUIS

C. CANCELLATION/TRANSFER FEES:

1. For each cancellation or transfer, minimum charge is \$20.00.
2. Transfer means to cancel from one Boeing Employees' Ski Club – St. Louis trip for the purpose of booking another Boeing Employees' Ski Club – St. Louis trip within the same season.
3. The trip captain will determine the charge for outright cancellations. Fees will be based on actual costs incurred, plus the \$20 service charge.

D. CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY:

1. To cancel a trip, the requester must make a **written request**. No refund will be made without a signed and dated written request.
2. Applicable cancellation fees listed in (C-3) will be levied if costs are incurred to execute the cancellation.
3. If no costs are incurred, the minimum charge (C-1) will be deducted from the refund.
4. If a suitable replacement is found, all money less minimum charge and actual cancellation costs specified in (C-3) will be refunded.
5. If a suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund will be made within four weeks after receipt of the replacement's appropriate payment(s).
6. If no suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund, if any, will be made within four weeks after the trip returns with a written request on file.
7. If the cancellation comes from a triple occupancy unit, and no suitable replacement is found, the person canceling will be responsible for the differential between the double & triple occupancy rate. This amount will be deducted from any refund.
8. The trip captain will provide a detailed explanation of costs incurred by cancellation to the requestor as part of the account settlement.
9. Any deviation from above will require action from the Club Refund Committee, consisting of the President, Executive Vice-President and Vice-President of Trips. Resolution of a deviation will be handled on a case-by-case basis. The \$20 minimum fee is irrevocable.
10. The Boeing Employees' Ski Club – St. Louis reserves the right to cancel the trip in its entirety if the number of attendees does not meet the minimum required to ensure financial viability. All attendee payments will be refunded if this action is taken.

E. OCCUPANCY: Trip is priced based on double occupancy per room, four people per condominium

F. SMOKING POLICY:

1. All unit assignments will be non-smoking regardless of lodging designation (ex. if the property manager lists the unit as "smoking").
2. The only exception to this policy will be if ALL roommates/condo mates agree to permit smoking in the unit.

THE BOEING EMPLOYEES' SKI CLUB – ST. LOUIS RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

I PERSONALLY ASSUME ALL RISKS IN CONNECTION WITH THESE ACTIVITIES, AND FURTHER AGREE TO INDEMNIFY THE CLUB AND ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, MEMBERS AND INSTRUCTORS, AND THE BOEING COMPANY, ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, AND EMPLOYEES FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION WHICH I MAY HAVE ARISING FROM MY PARTICIPATION IN CLUB ACTIVITIES.
