CORTINA, ITALY: 2/12 (SAT) – 2/22 (TUE), \$2,165

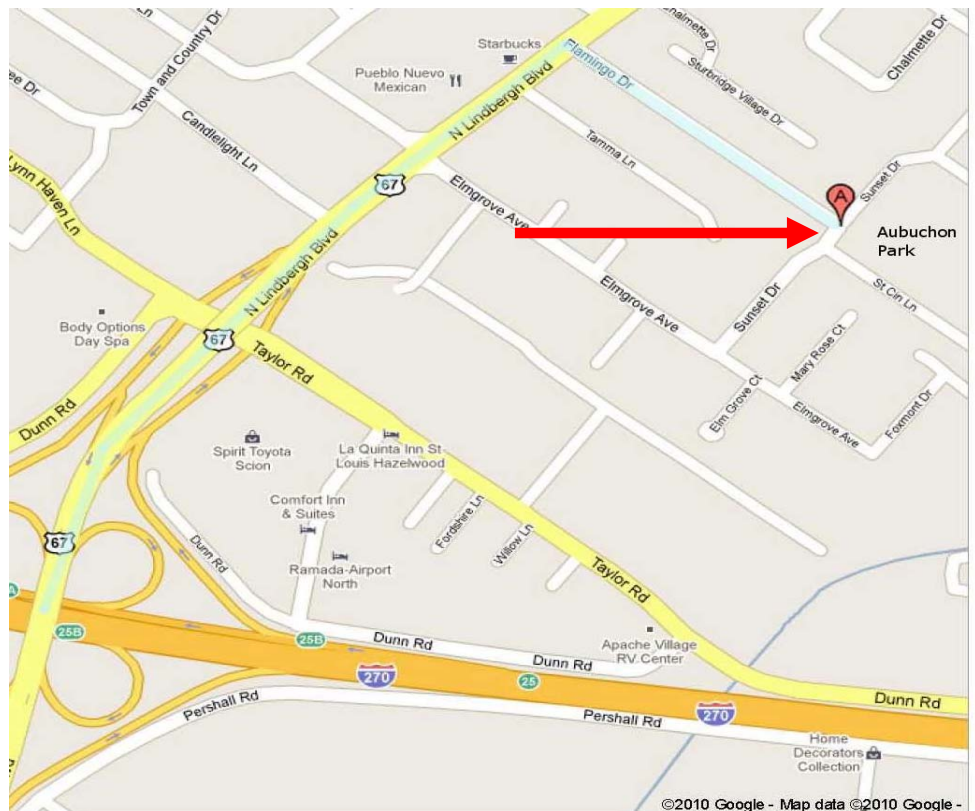
CHESTNUT MTN, IL: 2/25 (FRI) – 2/27 (SUN), \$280

To give everyone an equal chance to join a trip, we are once again adhering to the club rule that you or a sponsor needs to be at Sign-up night in person. The initial deposit and a signed trip application are required to secure your spot on a trip. Applications will be available at www.besc-stl.org or you can contact the trip captain directly. Sign-up will start promptly at 4pm. Please do not send your application or deposit to the trip captain before the August 28 or it will be returned.

Directions to Sign Up Night:

- From 270, exit at Lindbergh going North.
- Go approx. 0.5 miles to Flamingo Drive.
- Make a right onto Flamingo Drive.
- Flamingo ends at Sunset Drive and Aubuchon Park. Parking is to the right.



KEYSTONE, CO: 1/6 (THU) – 1/10 (MON)

Holiday lights are put away, all the parties are over, now what....LET'S GO SKIING!! Our Keystone Ski trip is just what you need to overcome your post-holiday blahs. One walk through the River Run Village, where our condo is located, will make it clear why we have come back to Keystone. Great shopping, dining, galleries and signature events are right out your door. The recently built River Run Condos are only a short walk to all skier services, including the River Run Gondola and Summit Express High Speed Quad. Our lift ticket is good for four resorts: Keystone, Breckenridge, A-Basin, and Vail (1 day only). Keystone offers three different mountains to ski with 2,227 skiable acres of terrain serviced by 24 lifts. Keystone Mountain is known for its groomed, wide trails, and designated slow skiing areas, perfect for families and beginners. North Peak boasts steep mogul covered runs, and smooth cruisers that cater to the more advanced skier. The Outback features glade tree skiing to offer the adventurous intermediate and advanced skier's powder skiing long after the main runs turn to packed powder. The three mountains are easily accessible from the River Run Base area. Breckenridge and A-Bain are just a shot bus ride away via the free Summit County Stage. Vail requires a "pay-as-you-go" shuttle that is available from the Keystone Base.

BIG SKY, MT: 1/22 (SAT) – 1/29 (SAT)

After a 16 year hiatus, the club makes a rare visit to Montana. Big Sky offers instant access to some of the most diverse skiing and snowboarding amongst breathtaking vistas. Float down a 2,000 vertical foot, powder filled bowl beneath Lone Peak; bob and weave through the Bavarian Forest; ride the Lone Peak Tram for a bird's eye view of untamed wilderness. You'll find almost twice as many acres as skiers - lots of elbow room. Big Sky contains 150 trails (14% beg., 26% int., 40% adv., 20% exp.) spread over 3,812 acres. There are 16 lifts to service the 4,350 ft. of vertical. The average snowfall is 400+ inches and the longest run is 6 miles. For an additional charge, you can also ski Moonlight Basin, which gives you access to an additional 80 trails on 1,900 skiable acres. We will be staying at Big Horn Condominiums. The units include washer/dryer, full kitchen, and fireplace.

Trip includes: round-trip air & ground; 7 nights lodging (6 per 3BR/3BTH condo); 5-day lift ticket; club race and several parties. Capacity: 30

NORTH LAKE TAHOE, CA/NV: 3/8 (TUE) – 3/13 (SUN)

The club invites you to ski the north shore of Lake Tahoe for 4 full days of skiing. Over 495 inches of annual snowfall is common on this side of the lake. We will be visiting 3 of Tahoe's finest ski areas. Alpine Meadows has 100 trails (25%-40%-35%), with 2,400 acres & 1,800 vertical ft., with 13 lifts. Northstar consists of 70 trails (25%-50%-25%), with 2,240 acres & 2,241 vertical ft, served by 15 lifts. Finally, Mt. Rose has 43 trails (30%-30%-40%) with 1,441 vertical ft of skiing. At no extra charge, you get fantastic views of Lake Tahoe! With 4 full days of skiing, this trip is a great value. A private coach will take us to the mountains each day. We are staying in downtown Reno at the Silver Legacy Hotel, which is close to all the action in the "Biggest Little City in the World".

Trip includes: round-trip air & ground; 5 nights lodging (hotel room, double occupancy); 4-days skiing (2 days at Alpine; 1 each at Northstar and Mt. Rose); club race and several parties. Capacity: 32

CORTINA, ITALY: 2/12 (SAT) – 2/22 (TUE)

The club's fourth European trip takes us to Italy, where the best skiers in the world tackled the slopes of Cortina at the 1956 Winter Olympics. You too can ski those hallowed mountains in this picturesque Italian ski sanctuary. Guaranteed snow cover on 95% of the slopes combined with 8 hours of daily sunshine produce sublime skiing conditions at one of the world's premier ski resorts. Surrounded on all sides by the breathtaking Alps, ski resorts at Cortina encompass the very best that world-class skiing, entertainment, and shopping have to offer. Cortina is part of the Dolomiti Superski, which encompasses 12 resorts with 460 lifts and 475 trails. Cortina itself boasts a vertical drop of over 6,600 ft, and its 3 primary ski centers (Tofana, Cristallo and Falaria) are an intermediate skier's dream, with 50% cruising runs. On a break from skiing or simply done with the mountains for the day? The Corso Italia is a pedestrian paradise lined with quaint boutiques and exquisite restaurants. Various day trips and non-skiing activities are available at an additional charge. We will be staying at the 4-star Hotel Concordia Parc. The trip will end with a 2-day stay in Venice, where you can explore at your own pace. We will be staying at the Hotel Continental, which is on the Grand Canal and near the train station.

Trip includes: round-trip air & ground transportation; 9 nights lodging (hotel room, double occupancy – 7 nights in Cortina, 2 nights in Venice); Breakfast & Dinner in Cortina, Breakfast only in Venice. Lift tickets not included. Capacity: 32

CHESTNUT MTN, IL: 2/25 (FRI) – 2/27 (SUN)

Join the club on our 4th annual Midwestern trip! Chestnut Mountain features 19 trails (longest trail: 2/3 mile) with a 475 ft vertical drop. The resort is served by 9 lifts, and has the largest terrain park in the Midwest. We are staying at the Ramada Inn & Day Spa in Galena, IL. The hotel is approx 20 minutes from Chestnut and 5 minutes from scenic downtown Galena and all it's shops and restaurants. The hotel features an indoor pool & hot tub; a full service spa; complementary hi-speed internet access and continental breakfast (with some hot items). The bus will depart Friday @ 4pm from the Bldg. 100 parking lot, and we will arrive back on Sunday evening at around 10pm. This is a great trip for first-timers and families! For non-skiers, we can deduct the lift ticket price.
