### A. TRIP PAYMENT:

1. **Make check payable to:** Boeing Employees' Ski Club - St. Louis
2. **Payment Schedule:** \$535 Deposit (due with application); \$530 due **10/25/19**; \$530 due **12/16/19**
3. **Cancellation policy:** Automatic cancellation if payments are not received on time and there is a waiting list. Please contact the trip captain IMMEDIATELY if a late payment is anticipated.

### B. GENERAL:

1. Prices are subject to change in transportation, lodging and lift ticket rates (and currency exchange -- where applicable).
2. Sign-up for all trips will start 24 Aug. 2019, and will require deposit in strict accordance with trip payment schedule.
3. All persons going on club sanctioned trips must be members of the BOEING EMPLOYEES' SKI CLUB – ST. LOUIS (BESC-STL)

5. For trips with air segments: flight schedule(s) are subject to change, which may impact some trip elements including arrival/departure days or times and trip activities on arrival/departure days. Travelers who arrange their own transportation that are impacted by their own or the group's itinerary changes are responsible for any costs associated with changing their flights and/or purchasing a separate ground transfer.

### C. CANCELLATION/TRANSFER FEES:

1. For each cancellation or transfer, the minimum service charge is \$20.00.
2. Transfer means to cancel from one BESC-STL trip for the purpose of booking another BESC-STL trip within the same season.
3. The trip captain will determine the charge for outright cancellations. Fees will be based on actual costs incurred, plus the \$20 minimum service charge.

### D. CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY:

1. To cancel a trip, the requester must make a **written request**. No refund will be made without a signed and dated written request.
2. Applicable cancellation fees listed in (C-3) will be levied if costs are incurred to execute the cancellation.
3. If no costs are incurred, the minimum charge (C-1) will be deducted from the refund.
4. If a suitable replacement is found, all money less the minimum service charge and the actual cancellation costs specified in (C-3) will be refunded.
5. If a suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund will be made within four weeks after receipt of the replacement's appropriate payment(s).
6. If no suitable replacement is found, the appropriate amount of refund, if any, will be made within four weeks after the trip returns with a written request on file.
7. If the cancellation comes from a triple or quad occupancy unit, and no suitable replacement is found, the person canceling will have the residual lodging cost deducted from their refund.
8. The trip captain will provide a detailed explanation of costs incurred by cancellation to the requestor as part of the account settlement.
9. Any deviation from above will require action from the Club Refund Committee, consisting of the President, Executive Vice-President and Vice-President of Trips. Resolution of a deviation will be handled on a case-by-case basis. The \$20 minimum service charge is irrevocable.
10. The Boeing Employees' Ski Club – St. Louis reserves the right to cancel the trip in its entirety if the number of attendees does not meet the minimum required to ensure financial viability. All attendee payments will be refunded if this action is taken.

**E. OCCUPANCY: Trip is priced based on double occupancy, unless noted otherwise. Single occupancy room may be available at a higher trip cost. Please contact the trip captain for information.**

### F. SMOKING POLICY:

1. All unit assignments will be non-smoking regardless of lodging designation (ex. if the property manager lists the unit as "smoking").
2. The only exception to this policy will be if ALL roommates/condo mates agree to permit smoking in the unit.

hereby acknowledge that I am aware of and understand that any and all snowsports activities, including but not limited to skiing, snowboarding, and racing (“**Snowsports**”) are hazardous activities and dangerous sports which can lead to property damage, serious injury, or even death and **that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence**. I understand and voluntarily agree to personally assume any and all of the liability and risks of Snowsports. I understand that these risks include, but are not limited to, contact with permanent and temporary fences, gates, posts, trees, snow making and snow making equipment, lift equipment and towers, rope tows and surface lifts, light poles, signs, buildings, roads and walkways, padded and non-padded barriers and obstacles, grooming equipment, snowmobiles, and collisions with other skiers and or snowboarders, spectators and other persons, and other natural and man-made hazards, equipment failures, exceeding one’s own abilities, the design, location, construction, inspection, maintenance, and repair of the ski area, changes in terrain, weather and snow surfaces.

Further, I agree it is solely my responsibility to determine the safety of the ski area’s facilities, including but are not limited to, ski trails and off-piste skiing and/or snowboarding, for my ability level. I acknowledge that the risks in Snowsports can be reduced by my taking lessons, by my abiding by the Skier Responsibility Code, and by my using common sense.

Further, if this Trip includes travel to or through any country other than the United States (“**Foreign Country**”) at any time or for any reason, I agree it is solely my responsibility to ascertain prior to the Trip that my travel to or through such Foreign Country will be acceptable to said Foreign Country, including but not limited to, my passport and/or under all laws and regulations of such Foreign Country. **I understand that laws and regulations of Foreign Countries can be and often are much different than the same laws and regulations of the United States.** By way of example only, a conviction of driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol in the United States can bar a person from admittance to Canada.
